- Scholarship applications and essays are due by the end of the day on Tuesday, April 6th.

Academic Merit Scholarships

	<p><u>Pfc. John Coleman Scholarship</u> Award of \$3,000 to a current freshman, sophomore, or junior who as an “A” average and ranks at or near the top of their class. The scholarship is for one year (2021-22 school year) but renewable each year if the recipient continues to demonstrate strong academic performance. Additional requirement: Letter of recommendation from an instructor on your moral character and academic superiority.</p>
	<p><u>Robert Schumacher Scholarship</u> Award of \$1000 is granted to a SENIOR who has a least a 3.0 GPA. Student must have a good behavioral standing. Student athletic managers with 2 years of service are preferred. Scholarship will be applied to the 2021-22 school year.</p>
	<p><u>George '45 and Mitzi Fischer Memorial Scholarship</u> Award of \$1000 will be granted to a returning student who has at least at 3.5 GPA. This student should excel in math and/or science. Scholarship will be applied to the 2021-22 school year</p>
	<p><u>Rachel Alfaro Memorial Scholarship</u> Award of \$500 will be granted to a new or returning student. Student should have a B average in grammar school or a 3.0 GPA in high school. Preference given to a Catholic, Hispanic student. The scholarship is for one year only and will be applied to the 2021-22 school year.</p>
	<p><u>Father Mathew Kish Scholarship</u> Award of \$1000 is granted to a returning freshman, sophomore or junior who demonstrates academic ability (min cumulative 3.0 GPA) financial need, and is a member of a Catholic Church. This scholarship is applied to the student’s tuition for one year only. Scholarship will be applied to the 2021-22 school year.</p>

	<p><u>Harold G. Rueth Scholarship</u> Award of \$1000 is granted to returning students who demonstrate academic ability (min 3.0 GPA), financial need and participates in a major school activity. This scholarship is applied to the student's tuition for the 2021-22 school year.</p>
	<p><u>Dorothy LaMere Memorial Scholarship</u> Award of \$1000 is granted to a returning student who demonstrates academic ability (min 3.0 GPA) and shows an interest in English or Writing. Scholarship will be applied to the 2021-22 school year. Additional requirement: Letter of Recommendation from an English teacher.</p>
	<p><u>Michael Buksar Memorial Scholarship</u> Award of \$1,500 to a current freshman (class of 2024) for her / his sophomore year. This scholarship is for the 2021-22 school year. It is renewable for the recipients junior and senior year provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA and is in good standing with the school. Preference is given to a student who is a current parishioner at St. John the Baptist and is an American citizen.</p>
	<p><u>Carol Muldoon Lambros `47 Memorial Scholarship</u> Award of \$1,500 granted to a student (current sophomore class of 2023 or junior class of 2022) who has a minimum GPA of 3.0, who demonstrates an enthusiasm for United States history, and the role that our U.S. military played in that history. It will be applied to the 2021-22 school year and is renewable for an additional year if the scholarship recipient is entering their junior year when selected. Additional requirement: Applicants will write a compelling essay on either the Revolutionary War, the Civil War, WWI, WWII, the Korean War or the Vietnam War.</p>

All need-based scholarship applicants must do the essay mentioned on Page 1 and submit financial aid forms along with a copy of 2020 tax returns.

Need-Based Scholarships

	<p><u>Bishop Dale Melczek Scholarship</u> Award of \$1000 awarded to a returning student that demonstrates academic ability and is a positive role model. This award is applied to the 2021-22 school year. It is not renewable.</p>
	<p><u>Larry Bentley Memorial Scholarship</u> Award of \$1,000 granted to one returning junior or senior that demonstrates academic ability and is a positive role model, helping others demonstrating strong moral character. This award is applied to 2021-22 school year only. It is not renewable.</p>
	<p><u>Bishop Grutka Scholarship</u> Award of \$1,000 granted to a student who belongs to the Diocese of Gary and demonstrates a strong desire to attend Bishop Noll, as well as financial need. This scholarship is applied to the student's tuition for the 2021-22 school year only. It is not renewable.</p>
	<p><u>Edward Schwoegler Scholarship</u> Award of \$1,000 granted. Student must be a member of the Gary Diocese or demonstrate financial need. The scholarship is applied to the student's tuition for the 2021-22 school year. This scholarship is not renewable.</p>
	<p><u>Ronald Partyka Memorial Scholarship</u> Award of \$1000 is granted to a student who demonstrates financial need and academic ability and is involved in extra-curricular activities. This award is applied to the 2021-22 school year tuition and is not renewable.</p>
	<p><u>Edward A Dyslin Scholarship</u> Award of \$1,000 granted to one student. This scholarship will be granted to those who are children of Arcelor Mittal employees first or those who demonstrate financial need. The scholarship is applied to the student's tuition for 2021-22 school year only and it not renewable.</p>
